Abstract: This document describes the abstract format instruction for papers in the 2017 T&T International Aerosol Conference (T&T IAC), which will be held at the Prince of Songkla University, Hat-Yai, Thailand during 7-8 August 2017. You are encouraged to follow this guideline and template strictly. The format of paper tiles is shown above and followed by the author's names, author's affiliations. The first page should include all above titles, names, affiliations, and abstracts in English (Times New Roman, 12pt.). The abstract should contain a single paragraph describing objectives, and a summary of significant results and its length should not exceed 200 words. Notably, maximum paper length (includes all figures, tables, and appendices) is two pages while edited with Microsoft Word document. All further information will be available at the website www.tt-iac.psu.ac.th.

Keywords: *(Times New Roman Italic 10pt, Justified to the left. Write your keywords 3-5 words)*

1. Introduction

The abstract text should be written in two column format using Times New Roman, 12 points, fully justified, line spacing = 1, with 6 points spaces before each paragraph. The text should be divided into sections as shown below.

References should be indicated by a superscripted letter in the abstract text and included in the section "Reference" using ACS style with full pagination as shown below.^{1,2} (leave a blank line between main sections)

2. Materials and Methods

2.1 General

The total length of the abstracts should not exceed 2 A4 pages.

2.2 Synthesis of Compound 1

Figures should be placed close to the location it is being referred to for the first time. (leave a blank line between main sections)

3. Results & Discussion

3.1 Subheading1

The figure size should fit either one or two columns format.

3.2 Subheading2

(leave a blank line between main sections)

4. Conclusion

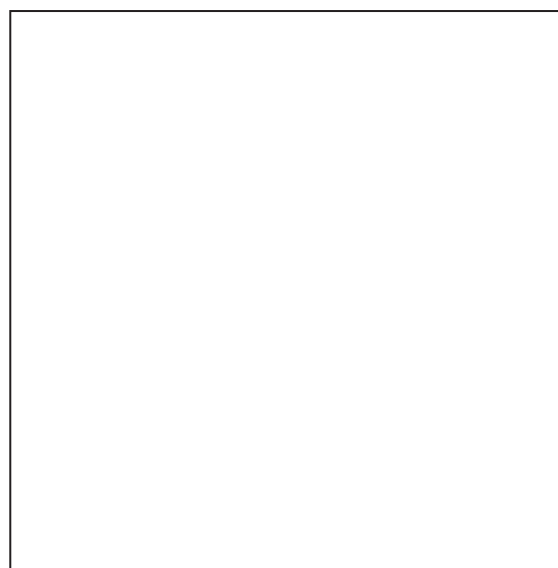


Figure 1. The layout of the figure should be set to in line with text (i.e., no floating figures). The figure must be in one complete piece. Annotation like the addition of labels etc. should not be made within MS Word. Figures should have

sufficient resolution to give the acceptable appearance at 100% zoom. All figures must be referred to from the text. Previously published figures must include a reference and a copyright statement.
